Ambergris Caye, Belize, Central America

February 21– 28, 2009



Ambergris Caye (pronounced Am-ber-GRIS Key), is located 35 miles north of Belize City. The island is a 24 mile long narrow strip of land and the hub of off-shore tourism. San Pedro on the southern end of the caye is the only town on Ambergris and has evolved into a laid-back international dive destination. The largest barrier reef in the Northern Hemisphere is just off the beach, making it a perfect launching point for an underwater dive excursion.



Lose yourself in the island accommodations at **Ramon's Village Resort!** An exotic beachside island paradise awaits you! Marvel at the stunning, authentic thatched roof cabanas, tropical lagoon-style pool, fabulous restaurant and the world-famous Purple Parrot, all the while being pampered by their renowned staff.

THINGS YOU MIGHT WANT TO KNOW ABOUT BELIZE

DIVING INFORMATION

Is Nitrox available?

Yes, you can dive nitrox, if you are nitrox certified. The cost is \$17 per tank**. If you are not certified, you can complete your certification with Adventure Scuba before you go. Call for details.

Can I do additional dives?

Yes, ala carte dives are available. A night dive is \$61** and additional afternoon dives are \$28**. The Blue Hole dive is available as an upgrade. Other popular upgrade dives would be the Turneffe Islands.

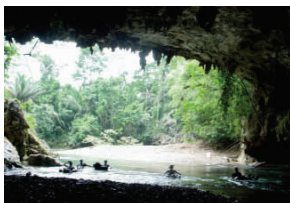


What kind of wetsuit will I need?

The average water temperature is in the high 70's to mid 80's. Depending on your personal thermostat, you will probably be most comfortable in a .5mm to 3 mm suit. Full suits are always a good choice for protection from the sun and from abrasions.

Popular choices for exploring above water Belize include Cave Tubing, and the Belize Zoo. \$160 ** (includes boat transfer to mainland)

Are there activities for non-divers?
